


DEAR PARENTS,

This is to inform you that we have received many reports from parents of **NEAR MISSES** during DROP OFF and PICK UP TIME at the Casserley entrance gate. Parents with small children as passengers have reported nearly being hit by another car in the car park.

We have observed that during both peak times (morning and afternoon), the Casserley ENTRANCE GATE can only SAFELY accommodate one flow of traffic - ENTRANCE ONLY hence it CANNOT BE USED TO EXIT because there is not enough room for cars to reverse and exit towards Casserley avenue. Therefore, can we please ask that all cars EXIT VIA SALCOTT GATE during drop off and pick up times.


PLEASE BE CONSIDERATE and strictly follow the traffic flow shown in the diagram below - **RED ARROW** for **ENTRY** AND **BLUE ARROWS FOR EXIT**. Your cooperation will highly appreciated.

PLEASE TAKE NOTE THAT IT ONLY TAKES <u>ONE CAR</u> TO MAKE THE WRONG EXIT AND THE REST OF THE TRAFFIC FLOW WILL BE BLOCKED AND VERY UNSAFE FOR OTHER PARENTS AND OUR CHILDREN.

The School is not able to nurse or supervise an unwell child for an extended period of time.

There are many occasions where our kids end up misplacing their essential items like bags, hats, homework bags etc. It is


