Dear Parents and Guardians

Thank you all for your warm welcome and kindness upon my arrival here at Emmanuel. I look forward to getting to know all the families during this period of adjustment and change and to serve you in this wonderful ministry.

A special welcome to all the new families that are joining the Emmanuel community for the first time. It is particularly exciting to know that this is the first year that Emmanuel will be offering Senior Secondary with the introduction of Year 11 followed by Year 12 in 2020.

Invoices have been sent to all families and FEES are due to be paid by FRIDAY 15th February 2019. Thank you to those families who have


