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PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Dear Parents, Carers and Families of Emmanuel,

MOVE-GIRLS PROGRAM

Edith Cowan University is conducting research to investigate ways for girls to become more physically active and feel more confident to participate in sport, games and

We are offering a free, 10-week fun-based movement program called Move-Girls at the Joondalup campus.

Eligible participants will receive an initial assessment of their fundamental movement skills, fitness, physical activity levels and selfconfidence. Results from the initial assessment are available to parents

Following testing, girls will be randomly allocated into Group A or Group B. <u>Group A</u> will start the program in Term 3 or 4, 2020 and <u>Group B</u> will start the program in Term 2 or 3, 2021.

The 10-week program includes targeted activities (including movement skills, strength and fitness), as well as expert instruction and feedback in a fun and non-threatening environment


