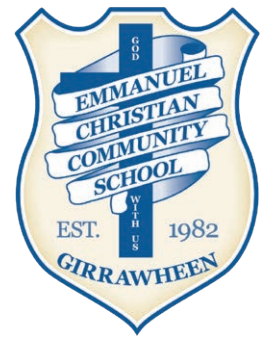

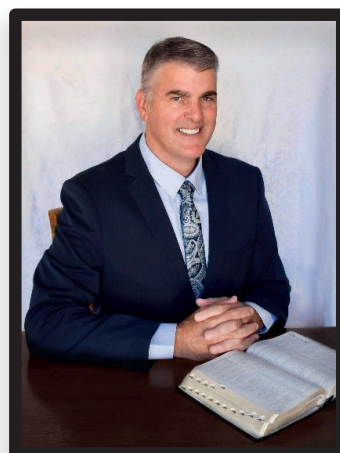
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## PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

**"We are pressed on every side by troubles, but we are not crushed.**

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
Principal's Message continued

The year 10 students cooking up a storm!! Learning how to bake bread with a visiting baker and getting confident in cooking independently making interesting dishes.

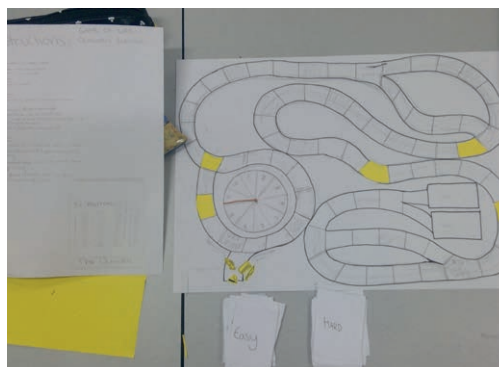
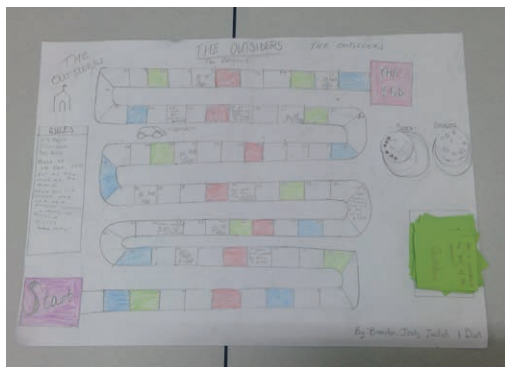
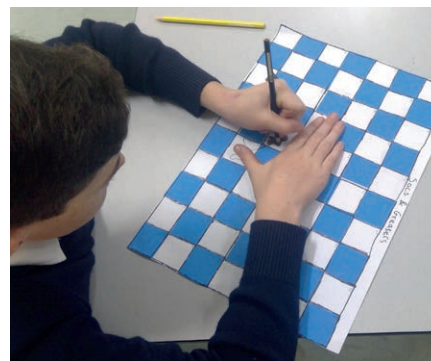
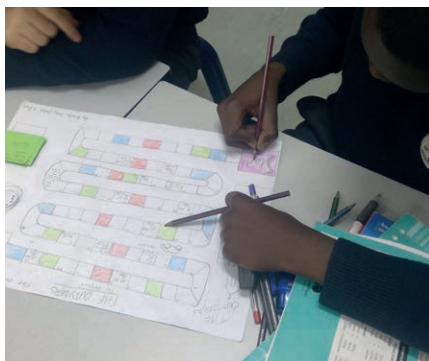
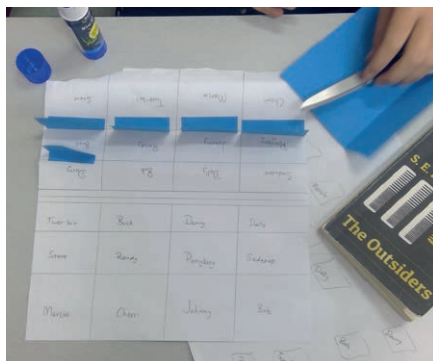

Meet the newest member of the Emmanuel family – **Mrs Belinda Cheung Sum Lam**.

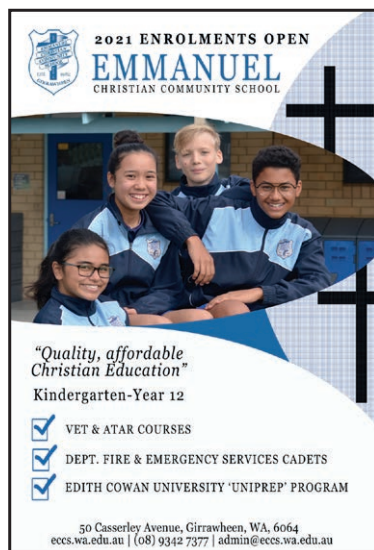

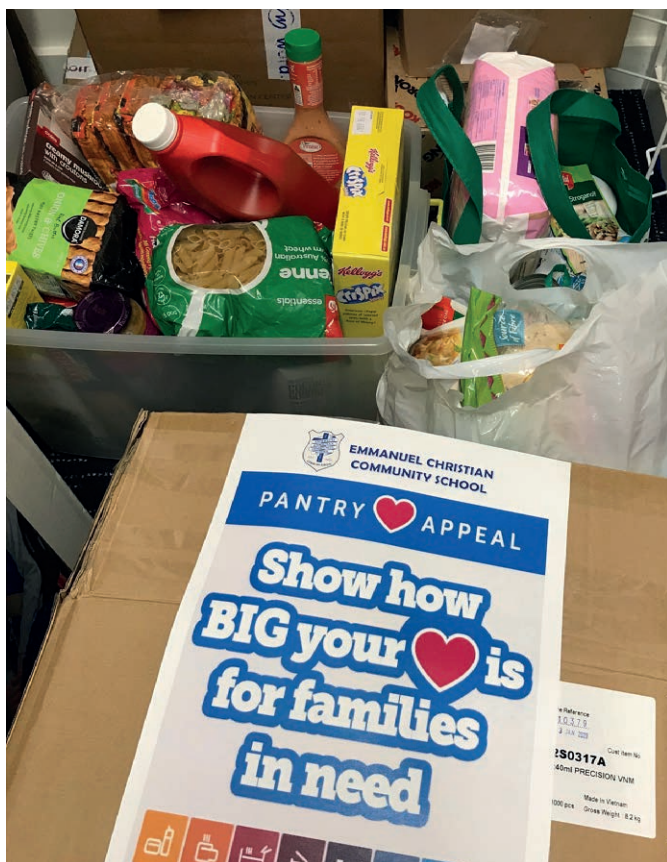
### FAMILY PANTRY APPEAL - A HUGE THANK YOU!
