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Dear Parents, Carers and Families of Emmanuel,

Welcome back to Term 3 and the ministry of Emmanuel Christian Community School.

As we hear of what is happening in other parts of the world, and in parts of our own country, we can feel blessed that in WA we are able to live relatively normal lives by continuing to be alert and proactive regarding COVID-19.



Following the advice of the Chief Medical Officer and State Government guidelines, we are still in Phase 4 restrictions and continuing a strict hygiene and cleaning regime at Emmanuel, which has enabled us to continue full attendance and face to face teaching.

We may know of family or friends that have been affected more significantly because of COVID-19. They may be suffering or in need due to the circumstances they find themselves in.

What should our response be?

Jesus' ministry showed immense compassion towards those who were sick, suffering, or in poverty.

He responded with kindness and concern and sought practical ways to alleviate their suffering. In the Gospels, we see Jesus expressing

compassion and demonstrating the father heart of God to those in desperate need.

The early Christians' commitment to caring for their neighbours and "the least of these" during times of wide-spread sickness, believers, and unbelievers, demonstrated the authenticity of their message of love and hope.

These Christ-like actions not only met a very practical need, but also attracted many outsiders to Christianity.

There are so many similarities between pandemics of the past and now, both in terms of how they have spread, and how people have tried to flee hot spots to protect themselves. But the biggest similarity, is the response of Christians. This is the time for Christians and Christian institutions to shine by showing the love of Christ to those who most need to know His love and compassion.

James states it quite distinctly when he says "Faith without works is dead"

¹⁴ What good is it, my brothers and sisters, if someone claims to have faith but has no deeds? Can such faith save them? ¹⁵ Suppose a brother or a sister is without clothes and daily food. ¹⁶ If one of you says to them, "Go in peace; keep warm and well fed," but does nothing about their physical needs, what good is it? ¹⁷ In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead. James 2:14-17 (NIV)

Mature faith is grounded in love and love without arms and legs is dead.

The word of God continually points us towards a way of life that is practical and fit for a 'time such as these'. We can put our trust in its instruction.



Do not put it off until the last minute because even when there are brothers/sisters enrolled at the school, if an application form is not submitted then a place will not be offered.



DROP OFF & PICK UP TIME

Please ensure your children come to school on time (8:30 AM) everyday and are picked up promptly after school **NO LATER THAN 3:30 PM**.

Please note that there is NO STAFF SUPERVISION after 3:45 PM and your consideration is appreciated as teachers also have families to go home to.



LATE ARRIVAL & EARLY EPARTURES

ALL Students who come to school late or are taken out of school early should report to the front office to SIGN IN - SIGN OUT via the school IPAD. The YELLOW & RED SLIPS will need to be presented to the class teacher before being allowed to join the class or leave the classroom.

Students who do not present this Card will not be allowed to enter or leave a classroom and will be sent back to the office to get one.

CHILDREN UNWELL

With Covid-19 still ongoing, the severe flu strain usually comes during the cooler months. So let's ensure our children don't pass on infections to others.
