

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BOOK WEEK


We are participating in Book Week 2020! This year's theme is **'Curious Creatures, Wild Minds**'.

ECCS SOCCER ACADEMY



All students in the primary years (grades 4 to 6) will have one contact session a fortnight in the soccer program.


