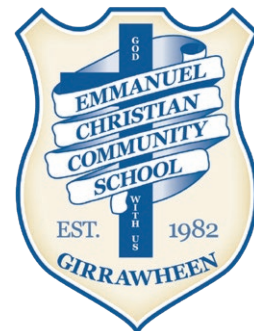

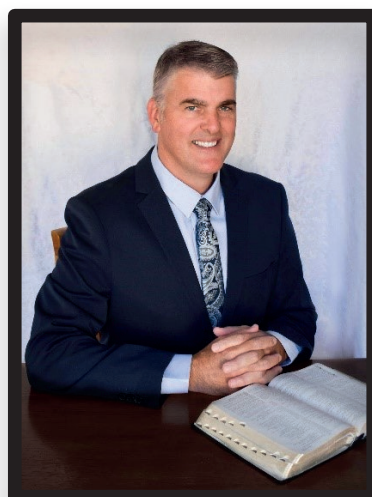

I am delighted to be back and look forward to a rewarding and joyful time in Term 4, celebrating our important end of year activities and exciting Christmas festivities!

Our first ever Year 12 students have been sitting their Mock Exams in the Casserly library this week. These exams will continue next week and normal classes will recommence for Year 12's on Thursday 15th October.



We are looking forward to seeing our Year 12 students graduate in week 2 of this term. Please pray for them at this time.

The building program in the Secondary Campus is progressing well with the second storey now being constructed. This also involves roadworks which will include a 'Wombat Crossing' and a 'Kiss and Drive' to improve pedestrian safety and traffic flow. 
Phase 4 Restrictions in Term 4

As Phase 4 of the WA COVID-19 roadmap has been extended until Friday, 23 October, the current Operational Guidelines remain in place (including the current Phase 4 cleaning regime). The new tentative start date for Phase 5 is Saturday, 24 October. A final decision on whether Phase 5 can proceed on this date, or if it can be brought forward, will be decided by the State Government.

Term 4 begins with students on Monday 12 October.

Students will all be expected to be in their summer uniform by week 3 of this Term.

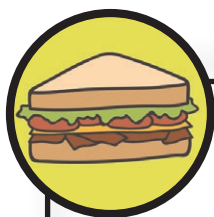

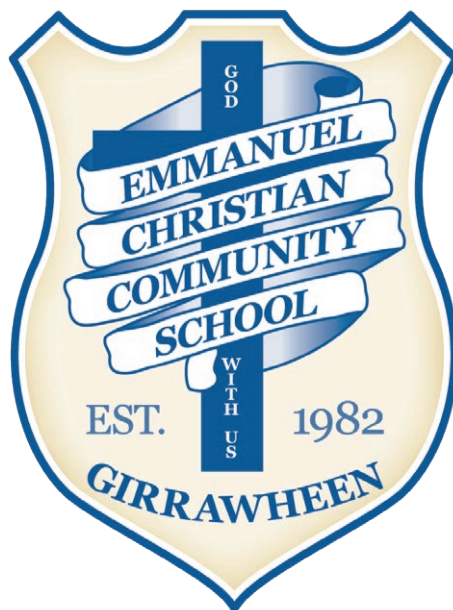
ECCS SOCCER ACADEMY
