COVID-19 UPDATE

From today Friday, 14 October mandatory isolation requirements for COVID-19, have been removed. This change was agreed at National Cabinet, meeting during the term break.

Please visit healthywa.wa.gov.au for up-to-date COVID-19 advice.

Students on work placement and work experience, and the staff who visit these students, will be required to follow any public health restrictions, testing and isolation protocols that apply to their work placement site. We still have an important role to play in supporting a healthy community and keeping our school safe and healthy. Children and young people sit together in classrooms and associate closely at school.

We ask that you support our efforts to keep ECCS healthy and safe by doing the following:

- ✓ Ensuring your child does not attend school when unwell
- ✓ If COVID positive, you and your children do not attend school whilst you have any symptoms
- ✓ Wearing a mask if you visit school feeling unwell or with a cough or cold

We will be continuing with the extra cleaning and hygiene routines at our school. Hand sanitizer will be used and masks remain available for use when and if needed.
